

call for entries

The IIDA Northern Pacific Chapter is proud to present the ninth annual **INawards**, a juried competition for interior design excellence and innovation. Interior designers, architects and industrial designers from the regions covered by the Northern Pacific Chapter (Alaska, Idaho, Washington, Alberta and British Columbia) are invited to submit entries of interior spaces and interior products completed after January 2010 (published or unpublished). Members of AIA and ASID are also invited to enter their projects at the Member price level.

Award recipients will be honored at an awards ceremony and announced in a press release shared with regional and national editors of trade magazines. The winning projects and products will also be announced through an IIDA Northern Pacific Chapter publication sent to local and national press, designers, and industry, as well as posted on the IIDA Northern Pacific Chapter's website [www.iida-northernpacific.org].

All entries will receive additional exposure via public display and voting for the People's Choice Award, as part of the Seattle Design Festival September 20-23, 2012.

award categories

From qualifying entries, one **Best of Competition** designation will be given in each category and **Honorable Mentions** will be awarded at the Juror's discretion.

design IN mass

This category recognizes projects completed in corporate, institutional, education, and government practice areas.

design IN hospitality

This category recognizes projects completed in hotel, spa, resort, restaurant, and retail practice areas.

design IN concept

This category recognizes un-built architectural interior projects, student work and conceptual or realized product design.

People's Choice Award

This award recognizes the project selected as best by vote of the general public – projects will be on view as part of the Seattle Design Festival.

design IN home

This category recognizes completed private single-family and multi-family residence projects.

design IN healthcare

This category recognizes completed hospital, clinic, and assisted living projects.

design IN public

This category recognizes completed public and civic projects.

Sustainability – honorable mention **NEW!**

This category recognizes the project judged to show the best accomplishment of sustainable goals or use of sustainable systems, techniques, or materials.

eligibility requirements

Interior designers, architects and industrial designers are eligible to submit interior spaces and/or architectural interior products completed after January 1, 2010. The design professional(s) primarily responsible for the design must submit the entry.

There are no restrictions on square footage in any category. There is no limit to the number of projects that can be entered by a firm or individual. One online entry, project board, and fee will be required for each project submitted. project entry **instructions**

Project entry and payment are online, with the exception of the project boards to be delivered or shipped. Below you will find a list and description of requirements and file naming conventions for project entry.

To begin project entry, go to <http://www.iida-northernpacific.org/ticket/inawards2012-entry>. Here you will be prompted for entry price type; click to the next screen and verify quantities before clicking “Checkout”. The following screen you will enter billing information and form of payment; click “Review Order” and then “Submit Order”. You will receive an email to the billing contact which will provide a link to the website to complete the entry requirements and uploads. When you have completed all required fields in the online entry system, you will receive a confirmation email for successful submission and instructions about the delivery/shipment of the project display board.

online billing information and payment

Entry fee is \$150 for IIDA, AIA, or ASID members*, \$200 for non-members, and \$25 for students. Receipt will be sent via e-mail. (*The firm or group entering must include at least one member, not necessarily the project team.)

Project statement

A description of your project, your client's objectives, square footage, budget, and date of occupancy or product launch date with a maximum of 400 words. Please make your statement as concise as possible, focusing on the following selection criteria, which are provided to the jury:

- Does the design reflect the client's culture and goals?
- Strong project design and detailing
- Project functionality and layout
- Strong concept statement and follow-through
- Innovative use of materials
- Socially conscious project
- Interior design is integrated with the architecture and influential environmental factors
- Project cost and its influence on design
- Accomplishment of sustainable goals or use of sustainable systems, techniques, or materials (indicate in Sustainability Summary)

Do not reveal your firm's identity in this project statement.

Project Summary

(PDF file of 4 MB maximum file size, 8-1/2"x11" layout, white background, black 12 point font, 100 words maximum)

To be read verbatim at the awards presentation should your project win an award – no more than 100 words.

Do not reveal your firm's identity in this project summary.

Sustainability Summary

(PDF file of 4 MB maximum file size, 8-1/2"x11" layout, white background, black 12 point font, 100 words maximum)

To be read verbatim at the awards presentation should your project win the Sustainability Honorable Mention award.

Do not reveal your firm's identity in this project summary.

Floor Plan (if applicable)

(PDF file of 4 MB maximum file size, 8-1/2"x11" layout, white background)

Do not reveal your firm's identity on the floor plan.

Finish Schedule (if applicable)
